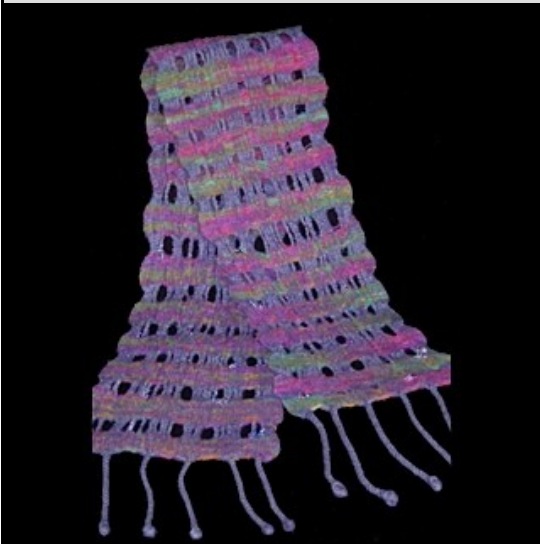


DEBORAH JARCHOW'S OPEN WEAVE FELTED SCARF ON THE KNITTER'S LOOM



Create an open weave using a rigid heddle loom. You can create a wonderful woven scarf that looks complicated, but is really very easy to weave. If you have previously taken a beginning rigid heddle weaving class, this class will add a new technique to your skills. If you still haven't tried this exciting fiber technique, now is the time to begin. Deborah will teach you how to calculate your pattern for felting to include the contrast tote flap and bottom. In addition she will show you how to make fringe cord.

STUDENT MATERIALS LIST

- 300-350 yards Newton's Yarn Country Fine Merino Wool (a variegated works well for this project)
- Note taking supplies
- A rigid heddle loom with at least 9" wide weaving width,
- 7.5 or 8 dent reeds
- Shuttles that came with your loom
- Scissors
- Waste yarn – acrylic worsted weight yarn is best (40 – 50 yds)
- Tapestry needle
- Straight pins
- Measuring tape
- Your basic weaving tools – like sley hook, threading hook, etc.
